Pioneer of ASDAO celebrates 90th birthday

Dr. Clarence Omans was born in Detroit Lakes, MN on Christmas day 1914. He lived in New York Mills, MN until the second grade. His family then moved to Battle Creek MI and he completed his primary education at Battle Creek

After attending one year at
Andrews University he became the driver for Dr.
John Harvey Kellogg for two years in Battle
Creek and Miami FL and

Academy.

attended college during that time at Battle Creek College. He then attended Illinois College of Optometry graduating in 1940.

After graduation he spent one year with the Ophthalmology department at the Battle Creek Sanitarium, doing vision exams and assisting with cataract surgery.

While there Dr. Omans met, with the introduction by Dr. Ralph Howard, his wife of 63 years, June. They were married August 31, 1941.

.Dr. Omans then opened a practice in Buchanan, Michigan for the next three years. Moving back to Battle Creek in 1944 he purchased a practice in the

At that time, he shared a visual training room with Dr. Ralph Howard.

In 1955 Dr. Omans and Dr. Howard purchased a filling station and remodeled it into a Optometric office and formed a partnership within two years. Dr. Omans retired from clinical practice in 1993.

The Omans moved to Hendersonville, NC in 1983, returning to Battle Creek to practice part time. Dr. Omans remains on the board and is the Vice President of Vision Services of Battle Creek.

In 1953 he sent out postcards to all the SDA optometrists that he knew trying tp get an Adventist Optometric association started.

About 1954 or 1955 Dr. Omans met with Drs. Barcelow and Osborn in Rochester, NY hoping to get the organization started. However it was in 1958 at the White Memorial Hospital in Los Angeles that Dr. Pete Heinrich facilitated an organizational meeting that started the ASDAO, (Association of Seventh Day

Adventist Optometrists.) Dr. Omans and his wife June, have attended every

ASDAO convention since the beginning. He is planning on being in St. Louis for the 2005 meeting.

The first convention was held in Squaw Valley, California in 1959. Dr. Omans was president in 1962 and has attended **every** convention since the beginning.

Dr. Omans served as the Assistant Director for Vision Affairs of the General Conference from 1987 until 2001. His work was helpful in working with and staffing the clinics in Africa. He along with other optometrists from the ASDAO worked hard in trying to form a college of optometry at Loma Linda

University, however It never came to be .

From 1976-1993 he served on the board of directors for the Battle Creek Sanitarium and now is on the hospital board of the Park Ridge Hospital in Hendersonville, NC.

Our best wishes and thanks to Dr. Omans for the work that he has done for the ASDAO and optometry. We plan on seeing him for many years to come.


