We do not have funds to pay for any containers but if there was a way to send some smaller items, it could be helpful. OR, if you were willing to help raise funds to buy such equipment here in Africa, that would be very helpful too.

In December there will be a group of students from Southern Adventist University coming to do some volunteer administrative work in Tanzania for a few weeks. Some will go to Heri Hospital. It could be that they might be willing to bring some items with them. I will make contact with their coordinator, Braam Oberholster, to see if this is possible.
