You will arrive at Union Station about 9:40 am. Leave Union Station, cross the Jackson Street Bridge and arrive at Chicago Trolley Tour stop # 14 (About 300 ft.). Get on the top deck of the Trolley for the best view. There are 15 stops. Stop # 12 has a free Hershey Bar and Stop # 3 has a free Garrett's Pop corn.
