

## ASDAO AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP FOR 3rd & 4th YEAR OPTOMETRY STUDENTS

The purpose of the ASDAO Auxiliary Scholarship is to recognize excellence in scholarship and encourage Seventh-day Adventist individuals with potential to complete their educational requirements in the field of Optometry.

Qualified Seventh-day Adventist students enrolled in an accredited school of optometry in either the US or Canada and completing the 2nd year are eligible and may apply for the ASDAO Auxiliary Scholarship which is given through the Association of Seventh-day Adventist Optometrists. The scholarship application is for a one-time scholarship given in either the Jr. or Sr. yr. of Optometry School.

All documents must be received no later than JUNE 1. The recipient will be announced during the annual meeting of the Association of Seventh-day Adventist Optometrists held the end of June each year. The scholarship committee reserves the right to suspend the award if no candidates are judged to be outstanding in a given year.

## **ASDAO GC VISION BOOTH**

The next SDA General Conference Session is little over one year away. We have been asked by the General Conference to provide a booth in the exhibit hall for vision care. After consulting with several veteran ASDAO members, we have decided to take a different approach to our vision booth and the services we provide.

As you know, measuring IOPs, VAs, and direct O-scope have very little diagnostic value to the attendees, and possibly giving a false sense of good ocular health. Even though this approach was well received by the public and perceived as a valuable service, we are looking at a different approach for 2015. Educating attendees about what a vision exam is and what we are able to see and diagnose would be in their best interest.

Here are some of the ideas we are considering:

- Eyemaginations has granted us the use of their full computer program during the convention time to show animations of ocular disease conditions, and ocular procedures. We plan to project these on a large screen or HD TV.
- OD's will provide consultations for medical conditions, give out AOA pamphlets, show Eyemaginations animations for appropriate ocular conditions, and educate attendees on importance of regular vision exams.

OCT screenings may be available for a select group of attendees Literature for healthy life styles

We need your ideas for our booth, for presentation and content. What brochures or information sheets we will provide need to be decided at the convention. E-mail us with your ideas and comments.

The eye program at the Villa Cochabamba clinic in Montero, Bolivia was started in 1996. We have been returning yearly, screening patients, doing surgeries, and training local surgeons. 2 to 3 young local Ophthalmologists staff the clinic on a part time basis year round, and 1 or 2 surgical teams visit each year to provide concentrated screening and surgical services. There is an onsite optical shop and we also can take donated eyeglasses from Lions international for the patients who come and do not have the resources to purchase glasses. We fly into Santa Cruz, Bolivia, which is about a 7 hour flight from Miami. It is then about a 45 minute drive to Montero. Housing is at a small, very clean hotel in Montero which also provides excellent food. There is an SDA church and school in town which is happy to have us visit. With advance planning Optometric teams could go down in advance and conduct clinics in some of the outlying villages. Patients identified as needing surgery could then come into Montero on the public buses. We are tentatively planning our next trip for the first part of November, 2015. Some knowledge of Spanish is helpful but not required.

## "Pathway to Health" April 8-10, 2015 Alamodome in San Antonio, Texas

Volunteers are needed to serve at your best PATHWAY to HEALTH – San Antonio this coming April 8-10, 2015.

"Pathway to Health" to a division of ASI National and is working in cooperation with the Southwestern Union Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists, Mayor Ivy Taylor's office as well as with the department of Public Health in San Antonio. Our goal is to provide 6,000 people with free medical, dental and vision care over three days, all free of charge to the patients.

Our target population is the uninsured and underinsured of the San Antonio area. Wholeperson care will include dentistry, vision care, surgery and primary care including services as massage therapy, physical therapy, laboratory, radiology and pharmacy services plus lifestyle medicine and chaplaincy services.

In anticipation of the 6,000 attendees, we need your help in Vision Services! We are planning several stations in the vision department: Prescreening, Refraction, Optical, Medical and Referral. Within each station, Optometrists will be assigned to help with triaging the results, refracting and educating on potential ocularmedical health diagnoses. The largest demand will be in staffing the 12-15 refracting lanes so that vision care will be available to as many attendees as possible over the 3 days. We have been blessed in partnerships with Essilor Foundation, VSP Mobile Eye Clinic, Prevent Blindness Texas and iCare San Antonio for resources and equipment.
